Cecilia Aisin-Gioro (Hengqin Aixinjueluo) is a direct descendant of the Qing Dynasty's royal family and the grandniece of the last Chinese Emperor, Pu Yi. Her artistic journey began at the age of five, rooted in the rich court traditions of meticulous and watercolor painting. Her early life, shaped by the Cultural Revolution and personal loss, led her to find resilience through art.

Cecilia holds a Bachelor's degree in Heritage and Museums, a Master's degree in Specialized History from Jilin University, and an MBA from Tsinghua University. She worked at the Shenyang Palace Museum and Shanghai Museum, where her mentorship with renowned artist Yifei Chen began, propelling her exploration into oil painting.

Now living in Canada, Cecilia has transitioned into a professional oil painter, creating vibrant, emotionally complex works. Her paintings blend cultural heritage with contemporary vision, resonating with audiences worldwide. Her works are collected by private collectors, galleries, and museums across the United States, France, Iran, the Philippines, Japan, England, Canada, and China.
