Biography

Born in the Soviet-controlled USSR, now Ukraine, Kate Stavniichuk is a realist artist known for her emotive and imaginative works. Despite early challenges, Kate began as a self-taught artist and by age 12 was exhibiting in galleries and winning awards internationally. At 21, she began working professionally across the United States and Europe, and at 24 held her first solo exhibition, 'Wild Passion,' in Kiev.

Her second solo show, 'Woman,' was exhibited in New York City's SOHO district, exploring themes of female empowerment and forgotten beauty. Kate's work has since been featured in international exhibitions, private collections, and magazine covers. She has been profiled in publications such as Art News Magazine, Art Ascent, and Average Art Magazine.

Kate's practice spans oil, acrylic, charcoal, pastels, graphite, and colored pencils. Her unique style merges realism and imagination, delivering messages that resonate beyond the visual.
