Biography

Rudolf Sokolovski is an artist and designer living in Vancouver, Canada. Born in Odessa, Ukraine, Rudolf apprenticed under his father, internationally acclaimed artist Valeri Sokolovski, from whom he received foundational art education and training. With a background shaped by classical European art, Soviet realism, and global travel, Rudolf has cultivated a distinctive style that is powerful, sensual, and modern. His sculptural philosophy, known as Tectonika and Linear Expressionism, focuses on the distribution of mass, flowing forms, and rhythmic lines to express emotion.

Rudolf's sculptures—often in bronze and wood—emphasize both visible and invisible elements of form. His works, featured in films, magazines, and exhibitions worldwide, are known for their elegance, texture, and emotional depth. Each piece serves as a dialogue between structure and sentiment, aiming to engage the viewer on multiple sensory and intellectual levels.
