Biography

Kamiar Gajoum discovered his passion for the arts in early childhood, expressing himself through theatre, acting, and sketching. At age nine, his artistic path became clear under the guidance of his stepfather, established artist Kal Gajoum. Their relationship mirrored the classical master-apprentice dynamic, enabling Kamiar to study traditional techniques and mediums while assisting in restoration work and collaborative projects.

Favoring oil as his primary medium, Kamiar combines brush and palette knife techniques, incorporating layering and glazing to create vivid colours and textured surfaces. Rooted in classical traditions, his style gradually evolved toward impressionism and contemporary themes. His work reflects a harmony between representational realism and impressionistic emotion.

Kamiar has traveled and lived in many of the cities he paints, infusing his scenes with lived experience and cultural atmosphere. He began exhibiting jointly with his stepfather and has since established a strong following through solo exhibitions internationally. Today, he is based in Tokyo and continues to inspire collectors worldwide with his evocative cityscapes and romantic visions.
